**Re: PAS 7050:2022 Bringing safe products to market  
PAS 7100:2022 Product recall and other corrective actions**

The UK's product safety regulator, the Office of Product Safety and Standards has been working with consumers and businesses to support the development of a Code of Practice that will help businesses understand their responsibilities to supply safe products to consumers.

PAS 7050:2022, Bringing safe products to market will help your business meet obligations under products safety law which requires that new and used consumer products placed on the market are safe. This PAS is intended for businesses, including manufacturers, designers, importers, distributors, repairers, refurbishers and the operators of online marketplaces for consumer products, to assist you in ensuring that only safe products reach the consumer. The PAS includes a number of checklists to guide and support your business assess compliance along with information on due diligence and relevant supporting documentation.

Furthermore, PAS 7100:2022 Product recall and other corrective actions has been reviewed and this Code of Practice will support your business in preparing for and dealing with a product recall or other corrective action.

New guidance has also been produced on how to notify products that pose a risk to health and safety and/or are non-compliant. This guidance sits alongside PAS 7100:2022.

Together, the new PAS 7050, the revised PAS 7100 and the associated guidance aim to help businesses have the appropriate systems and processes in place to enable the production of safe goods and to deal quickly and effectively if something goes wrong. All the documents take the form of guidance and recommendations and can be downloaded for free.
