# Portaferry Gala Week (13/07/2024 - 19/07/2024)

You will see that there has been some temporary surfacing laid into areas where the paving is not yet finished. This temporary surfacing will be excavated when Northstone Ltd start works again after the July break and these areas will be paved.

#### **CURRENT PLANNED WORKS**

Now that the summer break has arrived and the upcoming local festivities about to take place at the Gala Festival, Northstone Ltd have cleared the Square and surrounding areas to open as much access as possible to let the events take place.

When Northstone return to the site on the 22<sup>nd</sup> July, the first port of call will be to excavate the temporary surfacing to allow the paving squads to complete the Porphyry paving and Florentine cobbles in the Square.

The Civils crew will then continue with the excavation, kerbing, and concrete foundation of the footways in front of the Post Office toward the Old Rock Bakery.

Northstone Ltd would again like to thank the local residents and business community who have been extremely understanding of the disruption as they continue to do their best with what is a challenging project.

## **Schedule of Works**

Some changes have been made to the work plan and dates so please see revised work plan phases below. These changes are following consultation with Dfl, and work is now to be carried out to the footpath outside the Credit Union to improve pedestrian accessibility.

- Phase 1 Trial holes and Ferry Street Oct 2023-Dec 2023
- Phase 2 Castle Street Nov 2023 Feb 2024
- Phase 3 Market Square and Junctions of Ferry St/The Strand & Castle St/The Strand Jan 2024 Aug 2024
- Phase 4 Meetinghouse Street July 2024 Aug 2024
- Phase 5 Credit Union footpath and scheme conclusion Sept 2024

## Scope of scheme

Market Square / Castle Street / Ferry Street / High Street / Meeting House Street.

The Scheme Contractor, Northstone Ltd, will liaise with all of the residents and businesses within the scope of the scheme to try and reduce disruption during the period of works. Those traders and residents directly affected will be contacted by the contractor prior to works commencing.
