Purpose of the Equality Action Plan

The Equality Action Plan is important because of a law called Section 75 of the Northern Ireland Act 1998.

This means we have to treat **everyone fairly**, regardless of their religion, political views, skin colour, age, marital status, sexual orientation, disability, or family responsibilities.



We have to check if our services are fair. Sometimes, we find things that aren't fair.

We make **plans** to **fix** these things.

We want to improve things for everyone, and make sure our services are fair and easy to use.



The Council does many things to **help people** in our **area**.

They keep areas clean and nice

They help people in our community

They maintain public spaces like **parks** and **leisure** centres

They bring visitors to our area

They **speak** for people who live here

They decide how to spend money.



Elected Members:

40 people are **chosen** by you to **represent** you on the Council.

They decide **how Council money** and property is **used** and how to make our **area better**.

One Elected member is known as the **Mayor**, they represent our area.



About 1,000 **people** work for the Council all with **different jobs**.

The **Chief Executive** is the person in charge.

The **Leadership Team** manage departments, **making sure** that everything **works** and making **plans**.



The **Mayor** and the **Chief Executive** want the **Equality plan** to work well.

They will use all the things the **Council** has to **help** like **money, people and time.**



Getting Information in a Way That's Easy for You

The Council wants to make sure **everyone** can **understand important** information. So, they can give you:

- Big letters: If you find small print hard to read.
- Easy words: If you need things explained simply.
- Someone to **read** it to you: If you want to **listen** to the information.
- Translated into other languages: If English isn't your first language.
- Use sign language

We will use **Sign Video** more in Council **buildings** and have more **translation** services.




We want more **young people** to **tell** us what they **think**.
