- Is the Levelling Up funding allocated for Marine Gardens at risk if the developers are not permitted to take the green space? Please provide evidence of this.
- Was funding awarded for a specific project (e.g. play park/public realm)?
- Does converting open space into a revenue-generating car park comply with funding conditions?
- Has approval been obtained from UK Government / DLUHC for the change in scope?
- Could this expose the council to clawback of funding?
- How is private profit being justified using public funds?
- Council have not seen the LUF documents, therefore how could Council vote on a proposal without supporting evidence that this car park would risk the Levelling up funding?
- Damien Mitchell from Bangor Marine stated that evening, the car park would be privately funded, if so why would a privately funded car park risk the LUF?
