Cruise Ship Visit – Wednesday 27th May 2026

Commercial Pier

To facilitate a cruise ship visit (MV Viking Sky) on **Wednesday 27th May 2026**, the following restrictions will apply:

Vehicular access to the Commercial Pier will be **CLOSED** from **0800 hrs** to **1800 hrs**.

The Fuel Pontoon will be **CLOSED** from **0800 hrs** to **1800 hrs**.

Vehicle parking restriction: **NO PARKING** will be permitted in bays along the fence of BJ Marine's small boat yard (parking bays leading to the Commercial Pier).

Authorised coaches will park along the Commercial Pier ready to receive cruise ship passengers, who will disembark via the Marina Fuel Pontoon and exit via the Commercial Pier pedestrian gate.

While this vehicle restriction is in place, the landing of catch and bunkering of fuel to commercial operators will be permitted from the Eisenhower Pier. Please contact the Marina/Harbour Office for access to the Eisenhower Pier gates.

To ensure this is a successful cruise ship visit, we request that all fishermen remove items of fishing gear, including ropes, nets, and pots by the **morning of Tuesday 26th May**, allowing time for the Pier to be cleaned.

In closing, we would like to extend our thanks in advance for your cooperation and offer our sincere apologies to anyone who may experience inconvenience while these restrictions are in place.
