



NOTICE TO MARINERS

HEBRIDEAN PRINCESS – VISIT TO BANGOR

Saturday 30th May 2026

Mariners are advised that the cruise vessel Hebridean Princess is scheduled to anchor off Bangor on Saturday 30th May 2026, weather permitting.

Estimated Time of Arrival (ETA): 09:00 hrs

Estimated Time of Departure (ETD): 17:30 hrs

Location: Anchorage off Bangor Harbour

ISPS security measures will be in force throughout the duration of the vessel's visit, in accordance with the International Ship and Port Facility Security (ISPS) Code, as implemented under Regulation (EC) No. 725/2004 and the Ship and Port Facility (Security) Regulations 2004 (as amended) within the United Kingdom.

Subject to favourable weather and sea conditions, passengers and crew will be transferred ashore by tender throughout the day, landing at the fuel pontoon, which will be designated a TRA in accordance with ISPS Code requirements.

Fuel sales will remain operational; however, access to the pontoon for refuelling will be managed in coordination with tender movements to ensure the secure, safe embarkation and disembarkation of passengers and crew.

Mariners intending to use the fuel berth must contact the Marina Office in advance to request permission. Tender operations will cease when the fuel pontoon is open.

Please proceed with caution in the vicinity of the fuel pontoon and follow all instructions from marina staff.
