



DIVING PERMIT TO WORK

This Diving Permit to Work is issued by Ards & North Down Borough Council (ANDBC) for operations within Bangor Harbour and Bangor Marina. The permit controls all commercial diving activities and forms part of the Harbour Authority Safety Management System.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION (To be retained by Diving Supervisor)

Communications

- Harbour Communications: VHF Channel 11 (Bangor Harbour / Marina)
- All diving operations shall maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 11 at all times.
- The Diving Supervisor shall notify the Harbour Office prior to commencement and on completion of works.

Emergency Procedures

In the event of an emergency:

- Call 999 and request Coastguard.
- Notify Bangor Harbour immediately on VHF Channel 11.
- Implement the Dive Project Emergency Response Plan.
- Preserve the scene where safe to do so and cooperate with Harbour Authority and emergency services.
