TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF PUBLIC ACCESS

EISENHOWER PIER, BANGOR HARBOUR

Date: 17 July 2026

Mariners, harbour users and members of the public are advised that, due to public safety considerations and the planned arrival of HMC Valiant, a Border Force cutter, a section of Eisenhower Pier will be temporarily closed to public access.

Details

Location: Eisenhower Pier, Bangor Harbour. 54°39'58.29"N 005°40'09.48"W

Date: Friday 17 July 2026.

Restriction Period: From approximately 1400 hrs until 2000 hrs.

Reason: To facilitate the safe berthing of HMC Valiant and to ensure the safety of harbour users, members of the public, vessel crew and harbour personnel.

Physical barriers and signage will be in place to identify the restricted area. Members of the public are requested to comply with all instructions issued by harbour/marina staff and any supporting security contractor

Mariners should exercise caution when navigating in the vicinity of Eisenhower Pier during berthing of HMC Valiant and maintain an appropriate lookout for harbour operations and associated support craft.

The restricted area may be reopened earlier should circumstances permit.
